Dave Smith is Professor of Chemistry at University of York, where he carries out research into smart nanomaterials and nanomedicines, publishing ca. 150 papers, with an h-index >50. Dave has been recognised for excellence both in research and teaching, receiving the RSC Corday Morgan Award in 2012 and an HEA National Teaching Fellowship in 2013. In 2014, he was nominated as one of the RSC's 175 diverse 'Faces of Chemistry'. Dave entered into a civil partnership with his husband Sam in 2010.
